### **English**

To meet the objectives for this year group in English, we will be exploring an adaptation of Icarus and Daedalus. The children will be then be able to invent their own versions using Talk for writing. We will also be learning to write a non-chronological report, using our knowledge from our history lessons.

Our grammar will be developed through a focus on conjunctions and vocabulary in our writing. We will be focusing on different types of vocabulary and ensuring our work has coherency whilst improving our stamina for writing. Our spelling follows the Jane Considine approach in the 'Spelling book'.

# Mathematics

To meet the objectives for this year group in mathematics, we will be continuing to focus on fractions. We will be adding and subtracting fractions. We will also be multiplying fractions by integers. Then, we will begin to look at numbers with decimals.

As well as focussing on these key skills we will continue to practice children's fluency with arithmetic skills including calculating with the four operations. Alongside this, we will continue to practice times tables.

#### Science

As scientists, the children will be thinking about how plants and animals reproduce. They will be thinking about the evolutionary advantage of sexual reproduction, compared to sexual reproduction. They will also thinking about how some life cycles are different and why this is.

### **History**

As historians the children will be looking back at Ancient Greece. We will be thinking about different significant features which are still relevant to life today. We will use this information to create a non-chronological report.

### **Religious Education**

In RE, we will be focusing on the question: Why is the Torah so important to Jewish people?

#### **RSE**

The children will be discussing the importance internet safety and image sharing.

#### Music

We will be looking at pitch and beat alongside Symphonic Variations on an African Air, Coleridge-Taylor.

### **Creativity: DT**

This half term the children will be creating their own clay pottery. We will look at Ancient Greek pottery and include some of the key features. For example, we will think about the different shapes we may use and how to decorate them.

### Computing

Children will be looking at creating a web page during this half term. They will look at how to present information about safety.

#### **French**

Children will continue to develop their French vocabulary by learning to ask and give directions.
