Vocabulary	Definition
Clay	Clay is a type of natural soil. It has a plasticity when wet and becomes hard when dry.
Pottery	Pottery is pots, dishes and other articles made using clay.
Coiling	Coiling is a method of pottery that has been used for thousands of years. The clay is rolled into coils, which are then layered on top of each other to form the desired shape.

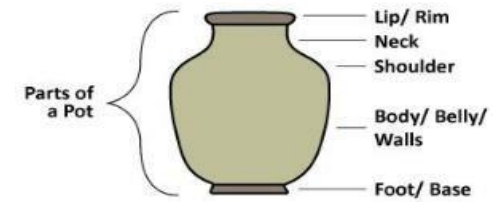
Ancient Greek Pottery would often be decorated with images linked to its use.

They had many uses for their pottery: cooking, food storage and decoration are just a few examples.

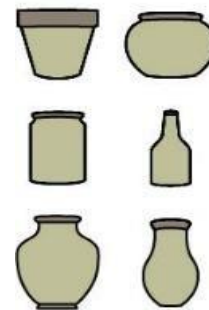


The pottery often had red, black or orange tones.
