<p>Phonics</p> <p>Watch this clip of a different teacher teaching one of our sounds. In light of the full day you have at home – try to complete the whole book. Start with the sounds, the green words, the red words, then read the story with a grown up, answer the comprehension questions at the back (you could write down your answers) and play the speedy green word game at the end. You could do this in several short stages across the day.</p>	<p>Spelling</p> <p>Today we were going to have our spelling challenge using the words from our half-termly homework menu. Practise them at home using some of the strategies on the back of the menu. Remember the words were: we, me, she, be, he, said, your, they.</p> <p>Maths</p> <p>Have a go at the Pirate Paraphernalia game. There are differentiated activities so choose the best one for you. If you want even more of a challenge then why not try the speedy challenge cards also attached?</p>
<p>RE</p> <p>We have been learning about the Shabbat celebration which takes place in Jewish households. Read through the powerpoint attached and then watch this short video clip www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/clips/z3hyr82. Talk about what you have learned with a grown up. Then look at the photo attached of a famous painting by the artist Alex Levin - https://artlevin.com/product/shabbat-shalom/. Discuss what you can see with an adult and then write down some sentences describing the piece. Why is it dark outside?</p>	<p>Treat yourself!</p> <p>Today we were going to be munching on our welsh cakes whilst watching a final episode of Katie Morag. Whilst this isn't possible what can you do at home as a little treat? Could you snuggle up on the sofa and watch a film, could you do some baking – perhaps make some scotch pancakes, or could you play one of your favourite family board games?
