



Digital Device	A computer or a device with a computer inside that has been programmed for a specific task.
Input Device	A piece of hardware used to control, or send data to, a computer.
Output Device	A piece of hardware that is controlled by outputs from a computer.





Website	A collection of interlinked web pages, stored under a single domain



Key Vocabulary	Definition
Computer System	A combination of hardware and software that can have data input to it, which it then processes and outputs. It can be programmed to perform a variety of tasks.
Transfer	To move from one place to another.
IP Address	A unique string of characters that identifies each computer using the Internet Protocol. Data can be sent from one computer to another using these.

A representation of how computer networks are connected.



Key Vocabulary	Definition
World Wide Web (WWW)	A service provided via the internet that allows access to web pages and other shared files.
Search Engine	A software program that helps people find the information they are looking for online using keywords or phrases. For example, Google or Bing.
Web Crawlers	A type of bot that is typically operated by search engines. It indexes (sorts) the content of websites across the WWW.
