Phonics Activity

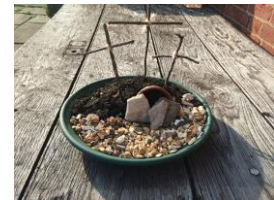
Each week until Thursday 16th March

Each Friday the children will bring home a phonics activity. This might be a game to play, a sound sheet to complete or even a wordsearch related to a particular sound they are finding tricky. The children will bring home their homework folder containing each week's homework which they will need to bring to school each Thursday thus practising and demonstrating their new secret skill of "Be organised".

Topic Activity

Friday 17th March – Thursday 30th March

Instead of sending home the weekly phonics sheets to be completed in the final two weeks of the half-term, we are asking the children alongside an adult at home to create an Easter or Spring garden. Head out on a nature walk or into the garden and responsibly collect items for your garden. You could create it in a Tupperware box, an old cookery tray or a gardening pot. Please bring these into school on Thursday 30th March for the children to share with their friends and receive their dojos.
