






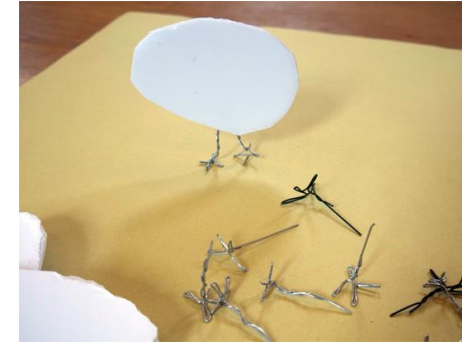


<b>Key Vocabulary</b> (previous vocabulary)		
<b>Sculpture</b>	3D art usually made from clay, wood, plaster, stone or wire.	
<b>3D</b>	3D objects have height, width and length.	
<b>Modelling Wire</b>	Soft and flexible wire that is easy to bend to make shapes for modelling.	
<b>Modroc</b>	Plaster bandages used for modelling.	
<b>Oval</b>	The shape of an egg.	
<b>Primary Colours</b>	All other colours are made from these. They cannot be made by mixing other colours. Red, blue and yellow are primary colours.	
<b>Secondary Colours</b>	A colour made by mixing two primary colours. Red and yellow = orange Red and blue = purple Yellow and blue = green
